

During the summer of 2021, Europe had suffered a massive heatwave that has caused a scruiciating hot weather and a record amount of wildfires. And among them, we have Turkey, that has been suffering with a massive amount of wildfires, starting from July 28 2021, there have been more 270 fires started in 53 provinces across the country, resulting in more them 17.000 acres of devastated land by the fire, killing at least 8 people and harming 864 others.

The flames have caused multiple evacuations by land and by sea of locals and tourists who were in risk areas, places like hotels, resorts, villages, farms and cities had to be completely emptied for the people's safety, it has also caused a great economic and also cultural and emotional lost for many people

Climate change around the globe is believed to be one of the main causes for the abnormal dry and hot weather that contributed to the wildfires. Many countries like the EU, US and Qatar are sending AID to help with the situation, as well as organizations like ERCC and the Turkish red crescent. The EU Civil Protection Mechanism has been activated as well as Qatar Red Crescent Society (QRCS) that made a partnership with Turkey's Disaster and Emergency Management Authority (AFAD)
