## ARTICLE III

of the Constitution establishes the judicial branch of Government with the creation of the Supreme Court.



## RESPONSABILITIES:

Hearing civil cases; Protecting individual rights granted by the state constitution; Determining the guilt or innocence of those accused of violating the criminal laws of the state; Acting as a check upon the legislative and executive branches of state government..

## WHO SERVE THIS BRANCH

The U.S. Supreme Court, the highest court in the United States, is part of the judicial branch. The Supreme Court is made up of 9 judges called justices who are nominated by the President and confirmed by the Senate.
