

#### **COLUMBIAN EXCHANGE**




### **INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION**





#### WESTWARD MOVEMENT




**Westward Expansion of the United States**


#### **URBANIZATION**



Segregation has generated the Great Migration, which changed the racial distribution of the US and finally, nowadays, the migration of Latin Americans is significant.
